Steps

TO FREE COLLECTION OF COMPLIANT TYRES

Tyres are counted as scheme tyres when they are reported to the scheme through the PRL and Repak ELT, and have the corresponding visible Environmental Management Cost paid.

STEP 01

Register

All operators in the tyre industry are required to register with Repak ELT and report the tyres they take in and out of their business.



STEP 02

Report

Reporting is online and must be up to date from October 1st 2017 and monthly thereafter by the 15th of each month.



STEP 03

Check if you are a producer

If you purchase tyres from an unregistered Producer outside the state you must register with PRL and report and pay the fee in relation to these tyres.



STEP 04

Charge vEMC

You must charge the visible Environmental Management Cost (vEMC) as a separate line item on all sales documentation and receipts.



STEP 05

Documentation

All members must display their Certification prominently at their premises.



STEP 06

Free Waste Collection

Compliant Retailers tyre waste will be collected for free by an authorised scheme collector and managed in an environmentally sound manner.
